Learning Agreement

The Learning Agreement must be sent to the Erasmus Office of the Faculty of Pharmacy (erasfarm@ucm.es) for approval and validation.

Even though the approved Learning Agreement includes a certain course, the confirmation of availability in such course only happens when doing the registration (enrollment) of the student, which usually happens upon arrival at the Faculty.

At the moment, there are no courses taught in English. All lessons and exams are in Spanish.

Language Requirement

A minimum B1 level of Spanish is required and a certification of the language level must be delivered in the online application.

Supervised Internship course

Incoming Erasmus students are not allowed to take the **Supervised Internship course (Hospital Training and Pharmacy)**, as there is a limited number of places and it cannot be extended to incoming Erasmus students.

Erasmus SMP Students (Students who wish to participate in a Research Group at our Pharmacy Faculty)

All students who wish to join a Research Group must get the prior approval and acceptance of the selected research group.

In order to get such approval applicants should select a research group from our web and request approval from the director of the group by emailing them and providing a CV, Presentation Letter, Transcript of records and any other relevant information.
